National School of Local Administration (NASLA) and Tayong Center for Leadership Development (TCLD) Sign Memorandum of Understanding to Enhance Training and Development Initiatives in Cameroon

The National School of Local Administration (NASLA), headquartered in Buea, South West, Cameroon, has recently entered into a strategic partnership with the Tayong Center for Leadership Development (TCLD) to bolster in-service training initiatives.

This collaboration has as principal objective, to promote strategic leadership and management training for Regional and Local Authorities. It aims at enhancing organizational performance in Cameroon, as well as soft skills and personal development, to support local governance and decentralization efforts in Cameroon. Hence, NASLA and TCLD shall be organizing 3 forms of trainings for regional and local governance actors.

First training is the senior Executive Leadership Programme (SELP) intended to brush up leaderships skills targeting Presidents of Regional Assemblies (their duties), City Mayors and Mayors to help them beef up their strategic planning, decision making, communications, performance evaluation, goal setting, and conflict management skills, as well as enhance their executive presence to lead their teams.

The second is an Executive Leadership Programme (ELP) that will focus on beefing up the operational and decision and team management skills of mid managers like Directors and Heads of Units.

Lastly, the 3rd training which is an Emerging Leadership Programme (ELP) will enable future managers gain key insights on leadership and also provide the opportunity to assess their individual leadership style and strengths.

NASLA, is a Public Administrative and Professional Institution, with a distinct legal personality and financial autonomy, established by a presidential decree in March 2020. NASLA is dedicated to providing professional training and conducting

applied research to enhance the management of Regional and Local Authorities (RLAs) in alignment with the government's decentralization policy.

On the other hand, TCLD, under the leadership of Mr. Peter Ngu Tayong, a retired UN senior diplomat and senior executive coach in strategic leadership and Management training, serves as a premier destination for leadership, soft skills, and personal development training in Cameroon and Africa.
